Here's what you need to know:

- Students2Work is a paid 6-week internship at a local business June 3 – July 9, 2024.
- Interns make **\$13/hr.** working 30 hrs./week. If selected, students attend a mandatory 3-day paid job skills training prior to internship.
- Students must be age 16 by June 3 and have valid identification (driver's license, state ID, social security card)
- Apply <u>HERE</u> through March 8, 2024!

PARENT/STUDENT INFORMATION

How long is the internship?

Students 2 Work internship program, an initiative supporting the mission of the Richmond County School System (RCSS), is June 3 – July 9, 2024. Employers host an intern for 6 weeks, 30 hours per week. A business may decide to allow the intern to work beyond the internship if student is available.

Will transportation be provided?

Please consider options that will provide daily and consistent student transportation for the duration of the internship. Transportation, such as Augusta Public Transit, may be available to and from work locations and program-related events.

How does the internship benefit the student? The internship program is designed to provide an educational experience that bridges the gap between classroom learning and intended careers. Students can connect with potential employers, meet positive role models, and gain soft skills training, literacy development, and financial management as well as receive career-path guidance.

What are the requirements for summer interns?

Applicants must be 16 years old by June 3, 2024, enrolled in Richmond County schools, in good academic standing, and on track for graduation.



How do I learn more about the program?

Information is available via guidance counselors at RCSS high schools and at students2work.org.

How are interns selected?

Once application process is complete, guidance counselors, teachers, business representatives and job-skills coaches will utilize a scoring rubric to select qualified students.

Upon hiring, what next steps for interns?

Students will be contacted via email with instructions on next steps. They will attend a MANDATORY orientation meeting and meet their assigned business leader on May 31, 2023.

Will students receive training?

Yes, there will be a mandatory 3-day paid job skills training May 29-31. Hosted by local business and education leaders, training will cover employability and soft skills, and lessons on attendance/punctuality, financial literacy, teamwork, and conflict resolution.
